Sir,

I am directed to invite a reference of this Department's letter No.B-12020/03/2009Ad.IX dated the 06.05.2010 on the aforesaid subject conveying the approval of the Board for extending the recognition of Income Tax Employees Federation (ITEF) with effect from 8 June, 2008 for a period of five years. Following the request received from the ITEF for further extension of the its recognition on following the verification of its membership for constituent charges/units, approval of the Board is hereby conveyed for extending the recognition of ITEF for a further period of five years with effect from 08.06.2013 to 07.06.2018 subject to the following conditions set out in Rule 6 of the CCS (RSA) Rules, 1993:

- (a) the Service Association shall not send any representation or deputation except in connection with a matter which is of common interest to members of the Service Association;
- (b) the Service Association shall not espouse or support the cause of individual Government servants relating to service matters;
- (c) the Service Association Shall not maintain any political fund or lend itself to the propagation of the views of any political party or member of such party;
- (d) all representations by the Service Association shall be submitted through proper Channel and shall be addressed to the Secretary to the Government / Head of the Organization or Head of the Department of office;
- (e) a list of members and office bearers and up-to-date copy of the rules and an audited statement of account of the service Association shall be furnished to the Government annually through proper channel after the General Annual Meeting so as to reach the Government before the 1st day of July each year;
- (f) the service Association shall be abide by and comply with all the provision of its Constitution / Bye-laws;

(g) any amendment to the Constitution / Bye-laws of the Service Association, after its recognition under these Rules, Shall be made only with the prior approval of the Add. UT, Ho (Admr) DC. Ha (Admr)

- (h) the Service Association shall not start or publish any periodical, magazine or bulletin without the previous approval of the Government;
- (i) the Service Association shall cease to publish any periodical, magazine or bulletin, if directed by the Government to do so, on the ground that the publication thereof is prejudicial to the interests of the Central Government, the Government of any State or any Government authority or to good relation between Government servants and the Government or any Government authority, or to good relations between the Government of India and the Government of foreign state;
- (j) the service Association shall not address any communication to or enter into correspondence with, a foreign authority except through the Government which shall have the right to withhold it;
- (k) the Service Association shall not do any act or assist in the doing of any act which, if done by a Government servant, would contravene any of the provision of the Central Civil Service (Conduct) Rules, 1964; and.
- (l) communications addressed by the Service Association or by any office -bearer on its behalf to the Government authority shall not contain any disrespectful or improper language.
- 2. It may also be ensured that the Member Employees will authorize the Drawing and Disbursing Officer (DDO) to deduct the monthly subscription from their pay roll and deposit in the account of ITEF. Further, under this system a Government servant can subscribe to only one Association and if an employee gives option in favour of more than one Association, his option will be treated as invalid.
